

PECUNIO CRYPTOCURRENCY TOKEN (PCO) SALE AND DELIVERY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following **Terms and Conditions** ("Terms"), including **PCO PURCHASE AND DELIVERY APPLICATION** and an excerpt from our **Privacy and Data Protection Policy**, govern your ("you" or the "**Purchaser**") purchase of cryptographic tokens ("PCO") from PECUNIO, a project of Pecunio Blockchain Technologies FZE, formerly C.B.C. FZE, a company registered in the United Arab Emirates (the "Company"). Each of you and the Company is a "Party" and, together, the "Parties" to these Terms. This document is not a solicitation for investment and does not pertain in any way to an offering of securities in any jurisdiction. This document describes the PCO token sale.

IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THESE TERMS, DO NOT PURCHASE PCO FROM THE COMPANY. BY PURCHASING PCO FROM THE COMPANY, YOU WILL BE BOUND BY THESE TERMS AND ANY TERMS INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS REGARDING THESE TERMS, PLEASE CONTACT THE COMPANY AT support@pecun.io. By purchasing PCO, and to the extent permitted by law, you are agreeing not to hold any of the the Company and its respective past, present and future employees, officers, directors, contractors, consultants, equity holders, suppliers, vendors, service providers, parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, representatives, predecessors, successors and assigns (the "PECUNIO Team") liable for any losses or any special, incidental, or consequential damages arising from, or in any way connected, to the sale of PCO, including losses associated with the terms set forth below.

DO NOT PURCHASE PCO IF YOU ARE NOT AN EXPERT IN DEALING WITH CRYPTOGRAPHIC TOKENS AND BLOCKCHAIN-BASED SOFTWARE SYSTEMS. **PRIOR TO PURCHASING PCO, YOU SHOULD CAREFULLY CONSIDER THE TERMS LISTED BELOW** AND, TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY, CONSULT AN APPROPRIATE LAWYER, ACCOUNTANT, OR TAX PROFESSIONAL. IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING TERMS ARE UNACCEPTABLE TO YOU, YOU SHOULD NOT PURCHASE PCO.

PURCHASES OF PCO SHOULD BE UNDERTAKEN ONLY BY INDIVIDUALS, ENTITIES, OR COMPANIES THAT HAVE SIGNIFICANT EXPERIENCE WITH, AND UNDERSTANDING OF, THE USAGE AND INTRICACIES OF CRYPTOGRAPHIC TOKENS, INCLUDING ETHEREUM TOKENS, AND BLOCKCHAIN BASED SOFTWARE SYSTEMS. PURCHASERS SHOULD HAVE A FUNCTIONAL UNDERSTANDING OF STORAGE AND TRANSMISSION MECHANISMS

ASSOCIATED WITH OTHER CRYPTOGRAPHIC TOKENS. WHILE THE COMPANY WILL BE AVAILABLE TO ASSIST PURCHASERS OF PCO DURING THE SALE, **THE COMPANY WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE IN ANY WAY FOR LOSS OF BTC, ETH OR PCO RESULTING FROM ACTIONS TAKEN BY, OR OMITTED BY PURCHASERS.** IF YOU DO NOT HAVE SUCH EXPERIENCE OR EXPERTISE, THEN YOU SHOULD NOT PURCHASE PCO OR PARTICIPATE IN THE SALE OF PCO. YOUR PARTICIPATION IN PCO SALE IS DEEMED TO BE YOUR UNDERTAKING THAT YOU SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS MENTIONED IN THIS PARAGRAPH.

PURCHASER AGREES TO BUY, AND COMPANY AGREES TO SELL, THE PCO TOKENS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

1. Conditions to PCO public token sale (ICO)

YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO ACQUIRE NOR RECEIVE A PCO TOKEN IF YOU ARE A CITIZEN, RESIDENT (TAX OR OTHERWISE) OR GREEN CARD HOLDER OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, OR A CITIZEN OR RESIDENT OF CHINA, THE UAE, AUSTRIA OR ANY OTHER EU COUNTRY. For any of these Countries, except China and the US, the company can under certain circumstances decide to issue PCO tokens solely on a “private placement” basis, in any case refraining from public offering. Under no circumstances, there will be more that 99 token buyers from any of these countries.

When you purchase, or otherwise receive, a PCO token, you may only do so by accepting the following conditions and, by doing so, you warrant and represent that the following are a true and accurate reflection of the basis on which you are acquiring the PCO tokens:

- Neither the Company nor any of the PECUNIO Team has approached you regarding a token purchase.
- **You approached PECUNIO, based on an existing client relationship with PECUNIO, on your own initiative, to acquire the tokens.**
- Neither the Company nor any of the PECUNIO Team has provided you with any advice regarding whether PCO is a suitable investment for you;
- You have sufficient understanding of the functionality, usage, storage, transmission mechanisms and intricacies associated with cryptographic tokens, such as Bitcoin and Ether, as well as blockchain-based software systems generally;
- You are legally permitted to receive and hold and make use of PCO in your and any other relevant jurisdiction;
- You will supply us with all information, documentation or copy documentation that we require in order to allow us to accept your purchase of PCO and allocate PCO to you;
- you have not supplied us with information relating to your acquisition of PCO or otherwise which is inaccurate or misleading;

- you will provide us with any additional information which may be reasonably required in order that we can fulfill our legal, regulatory and contractual obligations, including but not limited to any anti-money laundering obligation;
- you will notify us promptly of any change to the information supplied by you to us;
- you are of a sufficient age (if an individual) to legally obtain PCO, and you are not aware of any other legal reason to prevent you from obtaining PCO;
- you take sole responsibility for any restrictions and risks associated with receiving and holding PCO, including but not limited to these set out in Annex A;
- by acquiring PCO, you are not making a regulated investment, as this term may be interpreted by the regulator in your jurisdiction;
- you are not obtaining or using PCO for any illegal purpose, and will not use PCO for any illegal purpose;
- you waive any right you may have / obtain to participate in a class action lawsuit or a class wide arbitration against any entity or individual involved with the sale of PCO;
- your acquisition of PCO not involve your purchase or receipt of shares, ownership or any equivalent in any existing or future public or private company, corporation or other entity in any jurisdiction;
- to the extent permitted by law and provided we act in good faith, the Company makes no warranty whatsoever, either expressed or implied, regarding the future success of PCO and/or the Ethereum Network;
- you accept that PCO is created and you obtain PCO on an “as is” and “under development” basis. Therefore, provided the Company acts in good faith, you accept that the Company is providing PCO without being able to provide any warranties in relation to PCO, including, but not limited to, title, merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose;
- you accept that you bear sole responsibility for determining if (i) the acquisition, the allocation, use or ownership of PCO (ii) the potential appreciation or depreciation in the value of PCO over time, if any, (iii) the sale and purchase of PCO; and/or (iv) any other action or transaction related to PCO has tax implications.

2. Overview of PCO token

Token Legal Design

Pecunio token (‘PCO’; ‘Token’) is designed to act as a means of payment, a ‘digital coupon’, for all the products and services Pecunio provides, in particular ICO services and platform related fees. The tokens shall not be confused with company shares, which they are not. They are digital goods, bearing no intrinsic value by themselves, but the value of the assets, services and/or rights which can be purchased by these tokens.

Purchasing Voucher Business & Legal Model

A purchasing voucher in form of a ‘digital coupon’ is a common business model in the sphere of platform development. The idea behind this business model is to allow individuals the

purchase of, or access to popular, not yet released, items or products and has been often used in form of a pre-order by well-known companies like Amazon and Apple. This model is extensively used in the gaming and blockchain industry, yet the business model is flexible and, thus, can be easily applied across various industries including FinTech; the industry in which Pecunio Blockchain Technologies FZE primarily operates.

The purchasing voucher business model works the following way - Every platform user has the opportunity to purchase different types of products: The asset-backed token (PGC), various cryptographic tokens (PICO, PAV – future products), as well as the PECUNIO utility token (PCO). All platform related products and services can only be accessed with the PCO token, as a means of payment for fees and services. At the same time, new products and services are going to be released, which must be paid for in PCO. In case the ICO services fee, ownership of Pecunio tokens is a necessary prerequisite for pre-ordering these the new services. Naturally, entering into the pre-order agreement results in paying a certain fee.

PCO Tokens are accepted on the PECUNIO platform solely for the time being. Since the tokens will be released after the token generation event, secondary market trading is possible. Token buyers have to be aware that due to the utility nature of the token a rise in value is possible, however not the main goal of the project. Thus PCO tokens shall not be regarded as an investment.

Token Utility

PCOs are primarily a means of payment, „a digital coupon“ for all the services and fees Pecunio provides, especially ICO services and platform related fees, as well as for upcoming products. No other means of payment will be accepted for services. PCO allows buying of services and fees on the platform and acts as a value transfer with no other use. This is a pure utility function and has no profit sharing qualities signaling a low risk of Pecunio token being considered a security (*please contact us if you interested on learning more about token untility. Pecunio has conducted a thorough analysis of Pecunio token versus securities on the basis of the most applicable securities regulation with the help of external lawyers. However, as these legal and regulatory matters are in constant development internationally, this is only a momentarily assessment. We will closely monitor international regulatory development and act accordingly*).

3. PCO Price

Purchasers of PCOs will be allocated their PCO tokens in exchange for various cryptocurrencies.

Purchaser must have cryptocurrency in order to acquire any PCO tokens.

At the time of the order, there can only be a pricing indication, with respect to the actual purchase price on the ICONOMI platform. The actual PCO exchange price can be higher or lower than indicated, depending on the actual settlement price at the time of the purchase on the ICONOMI platform.

PECUNIO will execute all PCO orders received on its own platform from its existing clients within 3 business days. However it will try to execute on the ICONOMI platform within 24 hours.

4. Timing and conditions of PCO Token Sale

The PCO order is expected to be available from March 19th 2018th on, via public sale (ICO). Various restrictions and blacklisting apply, please refer above, to the white paper, AML/KYC policy, and the information given on our website. The public PCO sale will run for a month's time or when the PCO sale cap is reached. Apart from the public offering, the Company will conduct a limited number of private B2B / institutional transactions, provided legal and regulatory provisions are met. Pecunio expects less than 50 such private sales agreements in total. Under no circumstances, there will be more than 99 such agreements (hard cap on number of private sales).

IMPORTANT: UNCONDITIONAL EXIT CLAUSE: Pecunio does its best efforts in surveilling the local and international regulatory environment. In case of regulatory changes, regulatory tightening, or even a certain degree of uncertainty, the company reserves the right to unwind any transaction whatsoever at any time (voiding the sales contract), providing the purchaser full refund.

The Company reserves the right to change the sale dates or extend the sale duration for any reason, including the unavailability of the Website or other unforeseen security or procedural issues.

5. After the PCO Token Sale

The Purchasers should have no expectation of influence over governance of the Company.

Upon the conclusion of a successful PCO sale, the PCO tokens will be distributed.

Vesting periods

Please note, that the company has on its sole discretion, any right to impose, modify and cancel vesting periods at any time, on Tokens allocated to Supporters, Business Partners, Bounty partners, Airdrop receivers, Advisors, Employees, Referral other Service Providers, generally any party or user not exchanging ETH or BTC for the PCO tokens.

KYC/AML requirements ahead of delivery

Prior to a Purchaser receiving PCO after the PCO token sale completion, such Purchaser shall ensure that the buyer of any such PCO undertakes to fully comply with all the provisions of these Terms, the laws and regulations of the UAE, and all other terms and conditions the company has set, such as the KYC/AML policy.

6. Legal Jurisdiction

You expressly agree that any claim or dispute arising from your use of our website and/or our services will be governed by the laws of the United Arab Emirates (UAE). You further agree that any such claims or disputes shall be resolved in UAE courts, and you agree to be subject to the personal jurisdiction in, and the exclusive venue of, such courts and waive any objection to such jurisdiction and venue for the purpose of litigating any such claim or dispute.

7. All purchases of PCO are final

ALL PURCHASES OF PCO ARE FINAL. PURCHASES OF PCO ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. BY PURCHASING PCO, THE PURCHASER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT NEITHER THE COMPANY NOR ANY OF ITS AFFILIATES, DIRECTORS OR SHAREHOLDERS ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A REFUND FOR ANY REASON.

IF THE COMPANY BELIEVES, IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION, THAT ANY INDIVIDUALS OR ENTITIES PURCHASING OR ALREADY OWNING PCO CREATE MATERIAL REGULATORY OR OTHER LEGAL RISKS OR ADVERSE EFFECTS FOR THE COMPANY AND/OR PCO, THE COMPANY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO: (A) BUY ALL PCO FROM SUCH PCO OWNERS AT THE THEN-EXISTING MARKET PRICE AND/OR (B) SELL ALL CRYPTOCURRENCY ASSETS OF THE COMPANY AND/OR (C) COMPLETELY REVERSE / UNWIND THE TRANSACTION, AS STATED ABOVE.

8. Taxation of PCO and Taxation Related to the ICO

The Purchaser bears the sole responsibility to determine if the purchase of PCO with BTC, LTC, ETH or the potential appreciation or depreciation in the value of PCO over time has tax implications for the Purchaser in the Purchaser's home jurisdiction. By purchasing PCO, and to the extent permitted by law, the Purchaser agrees not to hold any of the Company, its affiliates, shareholders, director, or advisors liable for any tax liability associated with or arising from the purchase of PCO.

FOR THE COMPANY, PCOs ARE A MEANS OF FINANCING, AND ACCORDING TO THE UTILITY NATURE OF THE TOKEN (UNSPECIFIED VOUCHER FOR FUTURE SERVICES), WILL BE TREATED AS A LIABILITY (FUTURE PERFORMANCE OBLIGATION, FOR FURTHER DETAILS SEE IFRS 15) TO THE RESPECTIVE BUYER IN OUR COMPANY'S ACCOUNTING.

9. Privacy

The Purchasers may be contacted by email by the Company. Such emails will be informational only. The Company will not request any information from Purchasers in an email. See our Privacy Policy available on the Website for additional information

10. Force Majeure

The PECUNIO Team is not liable for failure to perform solely caused by:

- unavoidable casualty,
- delays in delivery of materials,
- embargoes,
- government orders,
- acts of civil or military authorities,
- acts by common carriers,
- emergency conditions (including weather conditions),
- security issues arising from the technology used,

or any similar unforeseen event that renders performance commercially implausible. If an event of force majeure occurs, the party injured by the other's inability to perform may elect to suspend the Terms, in whole or part, for the duration of the force majeure circumstances. The party experiencing the force majeure circumstances shall cooperate with and assist the injured party in all reasonable ways to minimize the impact of force majeure on the injured party.

11. Disclaimer of Warranties

THE PURCHASER EXPRESSLY AGREES THAT THE PURCHASER IS PURCHASING PCO AT THE PURCHASER'S SOLE RISK AND THAT PCO IS PROVIDED ON AN "AS IS" BASIS WITHOUT WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND, EITHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, WARRANTIES OF TITLE OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE (EXCEPT ONLY TO THE EXTENT PROHIBITED UNDER APPLICABLE LAW WITH ANY LEGALLY REQUIRED WARRANTY PERIOD TO THE SHORTER OF THIRTY DAYS FROM FIRST USE OR THE MINIMUM PERIOD REQUIRED). WITHOUT LIMITING THE FOREGOING, NONE OF THE PECUNIO TEAM WARRANTS THAT THE PROCESS FOR PURCHASING PCO WILL BE UNINTERRUPTED OR ERROR-FREE.

12. Limitations Waiver of Liability

THE PURCHASER ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT, TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY ANY APPLICABLE LAW, THE DISCLAIMERS OF LIABILITY CONTAINED HEREIN APPLY TO ANY AND ALL DAMAGES OR INJURY WHATSOEVER CAUSED BY OR RELATED TO (i) USE OF, OR INABILITY TO USE, PCO OR (ii) THE PECUNIO TEAM UNDER ANY CAUSE OR ACTION WHATSOEVER OF ANY KIND IN ANY JURISDICTION, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ACTIONS FOR BREACH OF WARRANTY, BREACH OF CONTRACT OR TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE) AND THAT NONE OF THE PECUNIO TEAM SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, EXEMPLARY OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING FOR LOSS OF PROFITS, GOODWILL OR DATA, IN ANY WAY WHATSOEVER ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF, OR INABILITY TO USE, OR PURCHASE OF, OR INABILITY TO PURCHASE, PCO, OR ARISING OUT OF ANY INTERACTION WITH THE SMART CONTRACT IMPLEMENTED IN RELATION TO PCO. THE PURCHASER FURTHER SPECIFICALLY ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE PECUNIO TEAM IS NOT LIABLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THIRD PARTIES, INCLUDING OTHER PURCHASERS OF PCO, AND THAT THE RISK OF PURCHASING AND USING PCO RESTS ENTIRELY WITH THE PURCHASER. TO THE EXTENT PERMISSIBLE UNDER APPLICABLE LAWS, UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ANY OF THE PECUNIO TEAM BE LIABLE TO ANY PURCHASER FOR MORE THAN THE AMOUNT THE PURCHASER HAVE PAID TO THE COMPANY FOR THE PURCHASE OF PCO. SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN WARRANTIES OR THE LIMITATION OR EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY FOR CERTAIN TYPES OF DAMAGES. THEREFORE, SOME OF THE ABOVE LIMITATIONS IN THIS SECTION AND ELSEWHERE IN THE TERMS MAY NOT APPLY TO A PURCHASER. IN PARTICULAR, NOTHING IN THESE TERMS SHALL AFFECT THE STATUTORY RIGHTS OF ANY PURCHASER OR EXCLUDE INJURY ARISING FROM ANY WILFUL MISCONDUCT OR FRAUD OF THE PECUNIO TEAM.

13. Complete Agreement

These Terms set forth the entire understanding between the Purchaser and the Company with respect to the purchase and sale of PCO. For facts relating to the sale and purchase, the Purchaser agrees to rely only on the Terms in determining purchase decisions and understands that the Terms govern the sale of PCO and supersede any public statements about the PCO token sale made by third parties or by the PECUNIO Team or individuals associated with any of the PECUNIO Team, past and present and during the PCO token sale.

14. Severability

The Purchaser and the Company agree that if any portion of these Terms is found illegal or unenforceable, in whole or in part, such provision shall, as to such jurisdiction, be ineffective solely to the extent of such determination of invalidity or unenforceability without affecting the validity or enforceability thereof in any other manner or jurisdiction and without affecting the remaining provisions of the Terms, which shall continue to be in full force and effect.

15. No Waiver

The failure of the Company to require or enforce strict performance by the Purchaser of any provision of these Terms or the Company's failure to exercise any right under these Terms shall not be construed as a waiver or relinquishment of the Company's right to assert or rely upon any such provision or right in that or any other instance. The express waiver by the Company of any provision, condition, or requirement of these Terms shall not constitute a waiver of any future obligation to comply with such provision, condition or requirement. Except as expressly and specifically set forth in these Terms, no representations, statements, consents, waivers, or other acts or omissions by the PECUNIO Team shall be deemed a modification of these Terms nor be legally binding.

16. Updates to the Terms

The Company reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to change, modify, add, or remove portions of the Terms at any time by posting the amended Terms on the Website. Any Purchaser will be deemed to have accepted such changes by purchasing PCO. The Terms may not be otherwise amended except by express consent of both the Purchaser and the Company.

17. Cooperation with Legal Authorities

The Company will cooperate with all law enforcement enquiries, subpoenas, or requests provided they are fully supported and documented by the law in the relevant jurisdictions.

18. Indemnification

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, you will indemnify, defend and hold harmless the PECUNIO Team from and against all claims, demands, actions, damages, losses, costs and expenses (including attorneys' fees) that arise from or relate to: (i) your purchase or use of PCO; (ii) your responsibilities or obligations under these Terms; (iii) your violation of these Terms; or (iv) your violation of any rights of any other person or entity.

The Company reserves the right to exercise sole control over the defense, at your expense, of any claim subject to indemnification under this Section 18. This indemnity is in addition to, and not in lieu of, any other indemnities set forth in a written agreement between you and the Company.

19. Security

You are responsible for implementing reasonable measures for securing the wallet, vault or other storage mechanism you use to receive and hold PCO purchased from the Company, including any requisite private key(s) or other credentials necessary to access such storage mechanism(s). If your private key(s) or other access credentials are lost, you may lose access to your Tokens. The Company is not responsible for any losses, costs or expenses relating to lost access credentials.

20. Language

Currently, only English versions of any PECUNIO's communications is considered official. The English version shall prevail in case of differences in translation.

21. Governing Law

The Terms, the arbitration clause contained in them, and all non-contractual obligations arising in any way whatsoever out of or in connection with these Terms are governed by, construed, and take effect in accordance with English civil law.

ANNEX A

PCO Risks

By purchasing, owning, and using PCO, you expressly acknowledge and assume the following risks:

1. Risk of losing access to PCO

A private key, or a combination of private keys, is necessary to control and dispose of PCO stored in your digital wallet or vault. Accordingly, loss of requisite private key(s) associated with your digital wallet or vault storing PCO will result in loss of such PCO. Moreover, any third party that gains access to such private key(s), including by gaining access to login credentials of a hosted wallet service you use, may be able to misappropriate your PCO. Any errors or malfunctions caused by or otherwise related to the digital wallet or vault you choose to receive and store PCO in, including your own failure to properly maintain or use such digital wallet or vault, may also result in the loss of your PCO. Additionally, your failure to follow precisely the procedures set forth in for buying and receiving Tokens, including, for instance, if you provide the wrong address for the receiving PCO, or provides an address that is not ERC-20 compatible, may result in the loss of your Tokens.

2. Risks Associated with the Ethereum Protocol

Because PCO and the PECUNIO platform are based on the Ethereum protocol, any malfunction, breakdown or abandonment of the Ethereum protocol may have a material adverse effect on the platform or PCO. Moreover, advances in cryptography, or technical advances such as the development of quantum computing, could present risks to the PCO and the platform, including the utility of the PCO for obtaining services, by rendering ineffective the cryptographic consensus mechanism that underpins the Ethereum protocol.

3. Risk of Mining Attacks

As with other decentralized cryptographic tokens based on the Ethereum protocol, PCO are susceptible to attacks by miners in the course of validating PCO transactions on the Ethereum blockchain, including, but not limited, to double-spend attacks, majority mining power attacks, and selfish-mining attacks. Any successful attacks present a risk to the platform and PCO, including, but not limited to, accurate execution and recording of transactions involving PCO.

4. Risk of Hacking and Security Weaknesses

Hackers or other malicious groups or organizations may attempt to interfere with the platform or PCO in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, malware attacks, denial of service attacks, consensus-

based attacks, Sybil attacks, smurfing, and spoofing. Furthermore, because the platform is based on open-source software, there is a risk that a third party or a member of the Company team may intentionally or unintentionally introduce weaknesses into the core infrastructure of the platform, which could negatively affect the platform and PCO, including the utility of PCO for obtaining services.

5. Risks Associated with Markets for PCO

If secondary trading of Tokens is facilitated by third party exchanges, such exchanges may be relatively new and subject to little or no regulatory oversight, making them more susceptible to fraud or manipulation. Furthermore, to the extent that third-parties do ascribe an external exchange value to PCO (e.g., as denominated in a digital or fiat currency), such value may be extremely volatile.

6. Risk of Uninsured Losses

Unlike bank accounts or accounts at some other financial institutions, PCO are uninsured unless you specifically obtain private insurance to insure them. Thus, in the event of loss or loss of utility value, there is no public insurer or private insurance arranged by Company, to offer recourse to you.

7. Risks Associated with Uncertain Regulations and Enforcement Actions

The regulatory status of PCO and distributed ledger technology is unclear or unsettled in many jurisdictions. It is difficult to predict how or whether regulatory agencies may apply existing regulation with respect to such technology and its applications, including the PECUNIO platform and PCO. It is likewise difficult to predict how or whether legislatures or regulatory agencies may implement changes to law and regulation affecting distributed ledger technology and its applications, including the platform and PCO. Regulatory actions could negatively impact the platform and PCO in various ways, including, for purposes of illustration only, through a determination that the purchase, sale and delivery of PCO constitutes unlawful activity or that PCO are a regulated instrument that require registration or licensing of those instruments or some or all of the parties involved in the purchase, sale and delivery thereof. [6] Beneficial owners will include, but not be limited to: (i) shareholders of a corporation; (ii) partners of a partnership; (iii) members of a limited liability company; (iv) investors in a fund-of-funds; (v) the grantor of a revocable or grantor trust; (vi) the beneficiaries of an irrevocable trust; (vii) the individual who established an IRA; (viii) the participant in a self-directed pension plan; (ix) the sponsor of any other pension plan; and (x) any person being represented by the Purchaser in an agent, representative, intermediary, nominee or similar capacity. If the beneficial owner is itself an entity, the information and representations set forth herein must also be given with respect to its individual beneficial owners. If the Purchaser is a publicly-traded company, it need not conduct due diligence as to its beneficial owners.

EXHIBIT A

DEFINITION OF U.S. PERSON

Rule 902 of the U.S. Securities Act of 1933

(1) "U.S. Person" means:

- i. any natural person resident in the United States;
- ii. any partnership or corporation organized or incorporated under the laws of the United States;
- iii. any estate of which any executor or administrator is a U.S. Person;
- iv. any trust of which any trustee is a U.S. Person;
- v. any agency or branch of a non-U.S. entity located in the United States;
- vi. any non-discretionary account or similar account (other than an estate or trust) held by a dealer or other fiduciary for the benefit or account of a U.S. Person;

- vii. any discretionary account or similar account (other than an estate or trust) held by a dealer or other fiduciary organized, incorporated, or (if an individual) resident in the United States; or
- viii. any partnership or corporation if:
 - A. organized or incorporated under the laws of any non-U.S. jurisdiction; and
 - B. formed by a U.S. Person principally for the purpose of investing in securities not registered under the Act, unless it is organized or incorporated, and owned, by accredited investors (as defined in Rule 501(a) under the Act) who are not natural persons, estates or trusts.

(2) Notwithstanding (1) above, any discretionary account or similar account (other than an estate or trust) held for the benefit or account of a non-U.S. Person by a dealer or other professional fiduciary organized, incorporated, or (if an individual) resident in the United States shall not be deemed a “U.S. Person”.

(3) Notwithstanding (1) above, any estate of which any professional fiduciary acting as executor or administrator is a U.S. Person shall not be deemed a U.S. Person if:

- i. an executor or administrator of the estate who is not a U.S. Person has sole or shared investment discretion with respect to the assets of the estate; and
- ii. the estate is governed by non-U.S. law.

(4) Notwithstanding (1) above, any trust of which any professional fiduciary acting as trustee is a U.S. Person shall not be deemed a U.S. Person if a trustee who is not a U.S. Person has sole or shared investment discretion with respect to the trust assets, and no beneficiary of the trust (and no settlor if the trust is revocable) is a U.S. Person.

(5) Notwithstanding (1) above, an employee benefit plan established and administered in accordance with the law of a country other than the United States and customary practices and documentation of such country shall not be deemed a U.S. Person.

(6) Notwithstanding (1) above, any agency or branch of a U.S. Person located outside the United States shall not be deemed a “U.S. Person” if:

- i. the agency or branch operates for valid business reasons; and
- ii. the agency or branch is engaged in the business of insurance or banking and is subject to substantive insurance or banking regulation, respectively, in the jurisdiction where located.

(7) The International Monetary Fund, the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, the Inter-American Development Bank, the Asian Development Bank, the African Development Bank, the United Nations, and their agencies, affiliates and pension plans, and any other similar international organizations, their agencies, affiliates and pension plans shall not be deemed “U.S. Persons.”
